Community Leaders to Announce United Way Campaign Status

December 10, 2003 – Dayton, OH – Leaders of the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce, Dayton Development Coalition, Downtown Dayton Partnership, Wright Patterson Air Force Base, and the AFL-CIO Regional Labor Council will join with United Way of the Greater Dayton Area to give an important update on the 2003 Campaign at a news conference on Thursday, December 11, 2003 at 11:00 a.m. at the Dayton Convention Center, Room 208.

Scheduled to speak are: Pete Luongo, 2003 United Way Campaign Chairman and member of the Board of Trustees of the Dayton Development Coalition; Phil Parker, President and CEO of the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce; Maureen Pero, President and CEO of the Downtown Dayton Partnership; Lt. Gen. Richard V. Reynolds, Vice Commander of the Air Force Material Command and Department of Defense Liaison of the Dayton Development Coalition. Other business and labor leaders will also be in attendance.
